



## AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS

Oh the thinks we will think this summer at SMACK, starting June20th, but before that we're having a Audition-who-be-whatee to help us prepare and place the cast into all the awesome and crazy characters "who" are in Seussical the Musical.

Please follow the instructions below.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Auditions will be held on **Saturday May 7th**, at your **scheduled time** in the lower part of First Assembly Christian School. Follow the signs and use the courtyard doors next to the Living Center.
2. Please be on time.
3. 3 rules to audition by:
  - Have Fun**—Enjoy auditions and the whole process! After all, you're gonna be in a musical!
  - Be Kind**—be supportive of others, quiet when it's not your turn, you're part of a team!
  - Do the Best You Can Do**—you are here to show us what **you** and **only you** can do.
4. **Singing**—Prepare to sing a song from the show provided in your packet that best shows your ability. Be aware that time constraints may limit us from hearing the entire song.
5. **Acting**—you should prepare lines from the script included in your packet or downloaded from our website. (when auditioning we prefer to see you read the script and act with character, although memorization is necessary for the performance, it is not desired for auditions)
6. **Dancing**—please wear comfortable clothes and shoes (no flip-flops). You will be learning a short, fun dance combination while at auditions.
7. You may be asked to read additional impromptu material at auditions.
8. In addition to auditions, campers will be having their costume measurements taken and receive their camp t-shirts and car pick up tags, so it is very important that every camper attend auditions.
9. We may or may not have call back auditions. As soon as the cast list is determined, it will be posted on the website.
10. Auditions are **CLOSED**. Parents, please do not ask to be in the room with your child during auditions. We understand that this may present a problem for some of our younger, less experienced actors. We promise to make this process fun and anxiety free. Parents are welcome to "hang out" in the cafeteria area until their child is done with the audition process.
